Sault Tribal Dental Program Operations during COVID-19 Crisis

- 1. All elective dental care will stop until normal operations resume. Scheduled patients will be contacted and appointments cancelled. Rescheduling of these appointments will occur when it is deemed safe.
- 2. Patients with a true dental emergency can present to the dental clinics between the hours of 08:00 AM 11:00 AM for care. Please call ahead if possible to see if the problem should be managed in the clinic.

Definitions:

- Elective dental care: all routine and preventative care like cleanings, exams, fillings, crowns, dentures, etc.
- True dental emergency: Toothache, pain, swelling, abscess, dental trauma, broken crowns, broken bridges and broken dentures.
