## Who is eligible?

- Sault Tribal members (adults and children) living in the 7 county service area for at least 90 days prior to applying. ( Mackinac, Luce, Chippewa, Schoolcraft, Delta, Alger & Marquette)
- Non-Native women pregnant with an eligible Native American child.



## How to sign up?

- You must complete and have a current application on file and approved prior to receiving services from PRC.
- Proof of income is used to determine eligibility for alternate resources such as Medicaid, Medicare, VA, etc. PRC is the payor of last resort , all insurances or other methods of coverage are to be used first.

## What are the responsibilities of PRC members?

- Schedule an appointment with your primary tribal physician. When necessary they will then provide you with an outside referral to a non-tribal health care physician or facility.
- Call PRC prior to services being provided for (authorization/voucher ) for your upcoming referral appointment.



## What is the process for After

## Hours, Emergency and Weekend care?

- When the tribal clinics are closed you must call the after hours nurse triage line in the area your primary provider is located. The nurse will provide medical advice and if needed will refer you to the closest walk-in clinic or emergency room.
- If you are referred by the triage nurse you then need to call PRC within 72 hours for your voucher.
